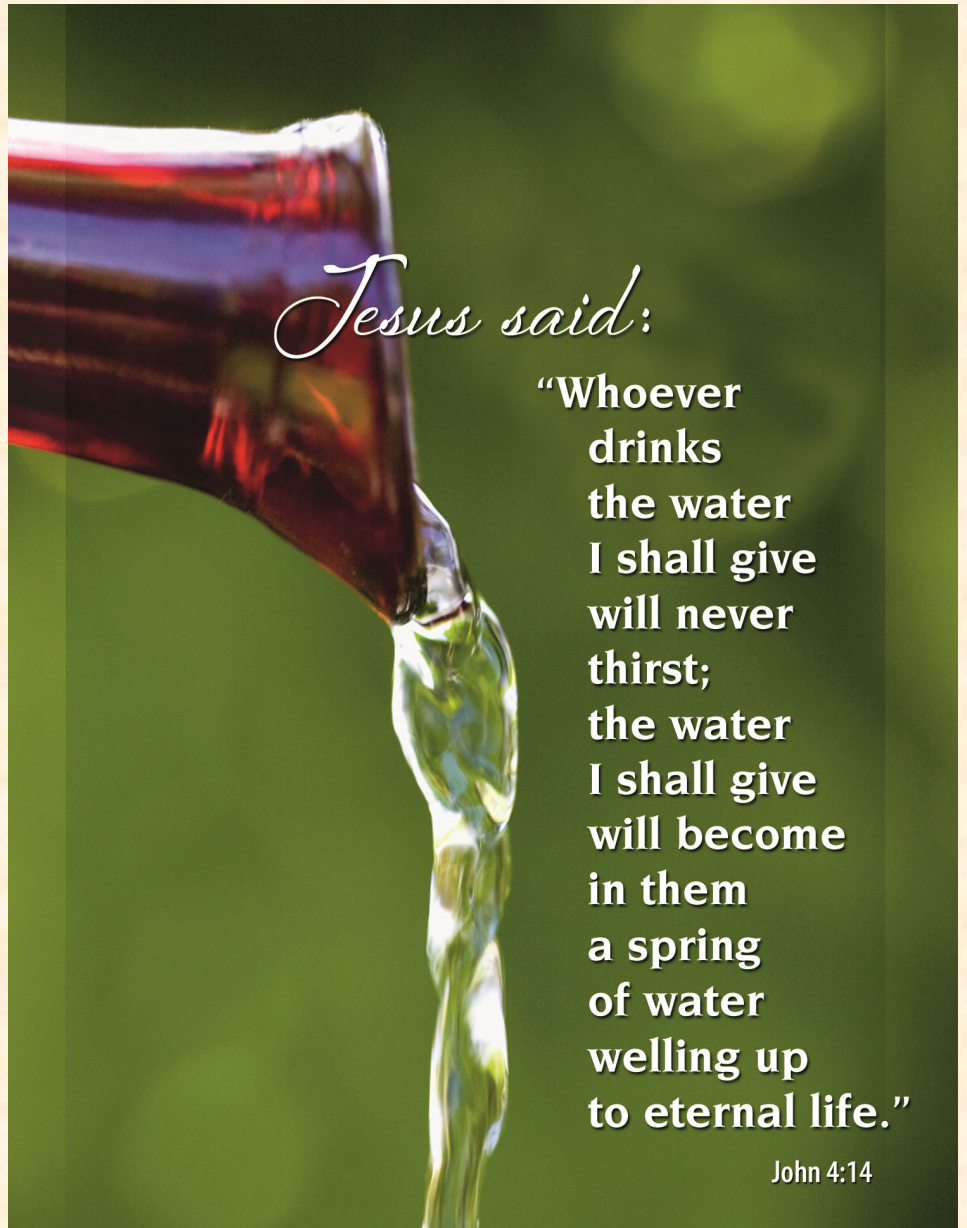

Dear St. Anne Parishioners:

I'd like to give you some updates on our **Bridge to the Future Campaign**, which is scheduled to conclude at the end of May 2018. We have divided the Campaign into 3 separate goals, which are as follows:

Number of Participants. We have 1,035 families at St. Anne, and have set a goal of having **200** families participate in the campaign. As of the last week, we have reached **137** participants.

Monthly Increase in Stewardship Giving. We have set the goal of increasing our monthly stewardship by **\$3,000**. As of last week, we have increased **\$1,975** in monthly stewardship giving. This is perhaps the most important category at this point, since it will most greatly impact our future giving. Please take a look at your monthly giving, and discern if you can commit to giving a little more.

Mortgage Reserves. Our goal in this category is **\$92,000**. So far, we have reached **\$71,702** in gifts and pledges.

If you have not yet made a commitment to the Bridge campaign, please pick up a form at the Information Table after Mass this weekend, and help us to reach these goals! The future of our parish depends on your generosity!!

A hearty "Thank You!" to all of those who have already participated in the campaign, and helped us to come so far.

Election of Trustee-Treasurer

Kathy Ciszewski is our current Trustee-Treasurer. Her term will end on June 30, 2017. This means we will need to elect a new Trustee-Treasurer. The parish corporate by-laws stipulate that trustees are to be selected "from and by the congregation." The pastor may also present one candidate.

If anyone in the parish would like to serve in this position or nominate someone, please use the nomination form on the next page that will require the signature of ten other registered parishioners. Nominations will need to be returned **by March 28**. If nominations are received, an election will be scheduled for April 2. If nominations are not received, the pastor may present a candidate.

What does the trustee-treasurer do?

He/She is responsible for keeping accurate and detailed accounts of receipts and disbursements for the parish. In general, this means being responsible for parish treasury activities including the care and custody of funds, assets, supervision of banking, credit, and insurance. This is done in partnership with parish staff and the Finance Council of the parish. He/She is an ex-officio member of the Finance Council.

Parish trustees are asked to:

- be registered in the parish
- be a practicing Catholic
- be at least 25 years of age
- make a two year commitment
- be willing to submit to a background check
- serve as ex-officio members of the pastoral council
- possess and/or acquire the same qualities as other pastoral council members
- receive appropriate training to the position
- participate fully in pastoral council activities including retreats and days of reflection
- embrace the same rights and responsibilities as other pastoral council members and work from the same sense of shared leadership and responsibility
- support and nurture the common vision developed by the pastoral council.
- participate fully and equally in decision making with other members of the pastoral council
- review and sign parish checks
- not serve as pastoral council officers, chairpersons of parish commissions, or coordinators of parish ministries.

Why do we have trustees?

Each parish in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee is an independent Religious Corporation established according to the Civil Statutes of the State of Wisconsin. The parish corporation is a civil body created solely for legal purposes. It has authority and competence only in those civil and secular matters for which it was created. Certain administrative matters dealt with by the Parish Corporation require that all five directors give their approval before the action is valid and legal. The members of each parish's board of directors are the archbishop, a vicar general of the archdiocese, the pastor, and two lay members of the parish referred to as "trustees." The officers of the Parish Corporation are:

President:	Archbishop	Vice-President:	Pastor	Board Member:	Vicar General
Treasurer:	Lay trustee	Secretary:	Lay trustee		

This legal reality becomes part of parish life with and through the parish council. The trustees cannot adequately carry out their responsibilities in the legal and financial aspect of parish administration apart from the pastor and other members of the parish council.

What about Pastoral Council Nominations?

Pastoral Council nominations will begin the weekend of April 22nd/23rd. You will be able to nominate yourself or any other parishioner you think has the qualities needed for spiritual leadership in our parish. We will need to select two people for 3-year terms. All those nominated will be contacted and invited to attend a meeting after Mass to learn more about the responsibilities of pastoral council membership. Those who attend the orientation meeting and would like to serve on Pastoral Council will be expected to attend a diocesan training session for Pastoral Council members. Those who have attended the training session will be invited to an evening of prayer and discernment at which they will select our three new council members. More information will be available in April.

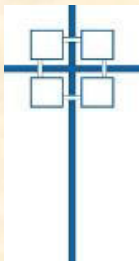

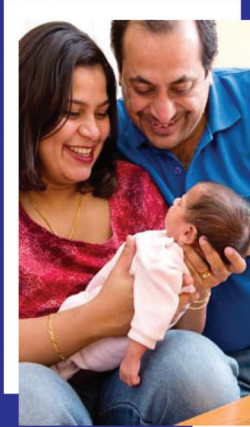

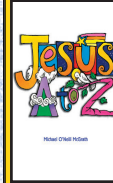
