Dear St. Anne Parishioners:

I'd like to give you some updates on our **Bridge to the Future Campaign**, which is scheduled to conclude at the end of May 2017. We have divided the Campaign into 3 separate goals, which are as follows:

**Number of Participants.** We have 1,035 families at St. Anne, and have set a goal of having **200** families participate in the campaign. As of the last week, we have reached **137** participants.

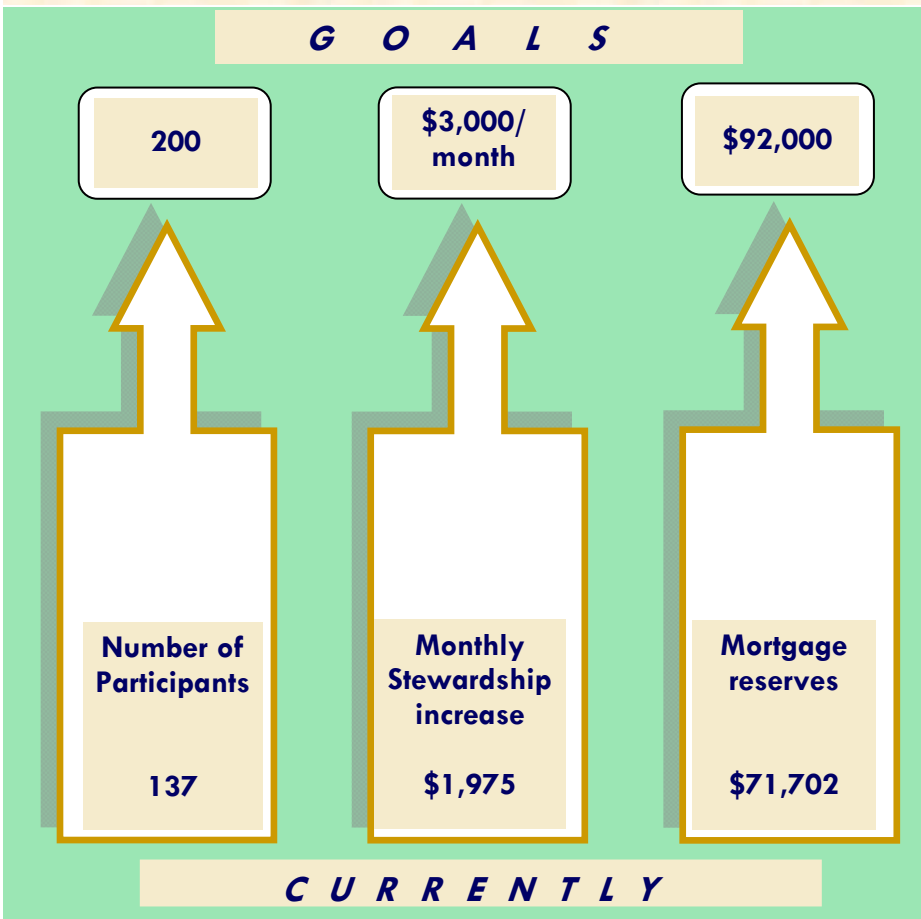
**Monthly Increase in Stewardship Giving.** We have set the goal of increasing our monthly stewardship by **\$3,000**. As of last week, we have increased **\$1,975** in monthly stewardship giving. This is perhaps the most important category at this point, since it will most greatly impact our future giving. Please take a look at your monthly giving, and discern if you can commit to giving a little more.

**Mortgage Reserves.** Our goal in this category is **\$92,000**. So far, we have reached **\$71,702** in gifts and pledges.

If you have not yet made a commitment to the Bridge campaign, please pick up a form at the Information Table after Mass this weekend, and help us to reach these goals! The future of our parish depends on your generosity!!

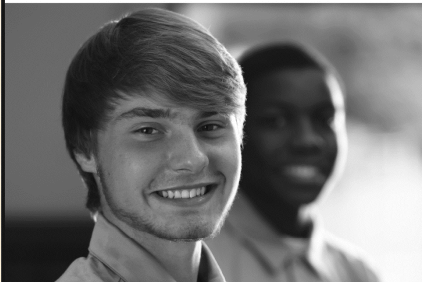

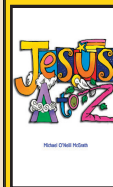
