God so Love the World

When we hear in the oft-quoted text in John 3:16 that "God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life," we begin to see how language that expresses the sending of the Son fails to express the unity of the Holy Trinity. This failure of human language in the presence of the mystery of the Trinity is what makes it so hard to explain and comprehend.

So how can we respond when we see a reference to "God"? We can strive to remember that God is three persons, not just one as we are, but one in being. Our best response is praise to the Holy Trinity. "Glory to the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, to God who is, who was, and who is to come." And we can bless each other when we pray with Saint Paul, "The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with all of you" (2 Corinthians 13:13).

Over the past several weeks St. Anne has encouraged the donation of Scrip cards to help our family while we struggle with financial hardship. We are waiting for the Social Security Administration to approve my husband's application for disability. (It has been 8 months since he applied). Three years ago, my husband had a stroke but was able to return to work for two years. He continued to have additional health issues – primarily hemiplegic migraines that affect him on average every other day adding to his progressive ataxia making his disability life altering to our family. The help we have received from the parish is so appreciated and continues to help keep us going. We have been able to buy groceries, get room darkening drapes to help relieve part of his pain when his migraines attack, prescription co-pays and gasoline. We are so humbled and grateful for the help and prayers and just wanted to express our thanks to all who heard and assisted our call.

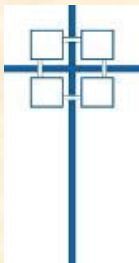
