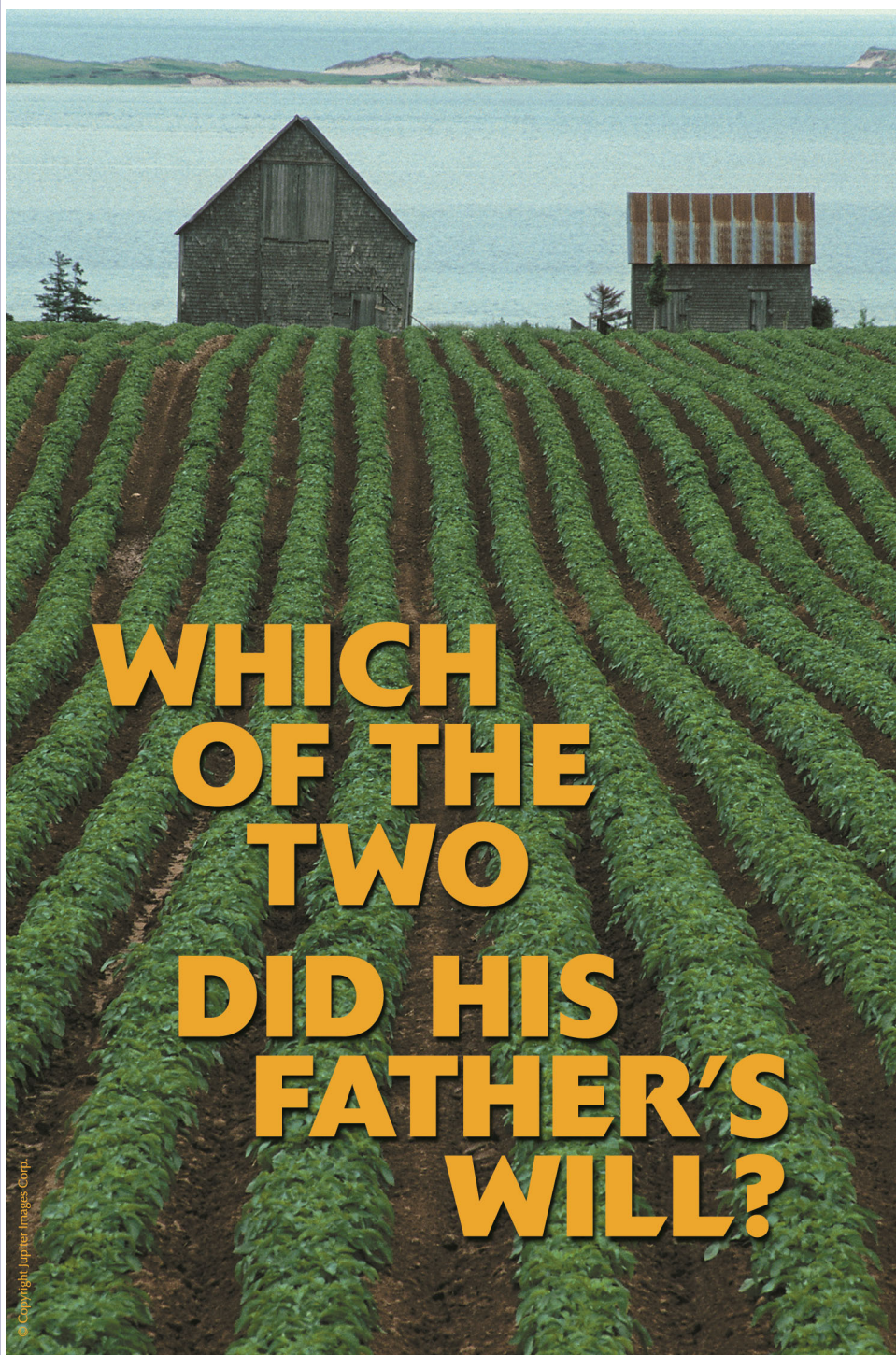

Changing Your Mind

The readings today make it clear that to be a follower of Jesus you have to be able to change your mind. More precisely, we must allow God to change us, to transform our minds. For most of us, this can be really hard. This is why the readings speak so much about humility. Humility opens up our capacity to be transformed. Humility allows us to challenge our own thinking and behavior, so as to avoid self-justification on one hand, and self-denigration on the other hand.

Humility can be cultivated in the practice of reflection. This might mean claiming some time to allow God into our busy days. This might mean time away, through a retreat or day of quiet, perhaps with the help of a spiritual guide or director.

Humility can also be cultivated in actions of service. We learn Jesus' humility through washing each other's feet. We can place other's interests ahead of our own, and relinquish our need to be in control. When we cultivate humility, we create space within us to allow God to take residence and transform us.

RCIA/Adult Confirmation Prep has begun. The next meeting is October 9th and every two weeks thereafter at 7:30 p.m. The Catholic Church designed the RCIA process for everyone; adult or child over seven years of age, who is: yearning for something more in their lives; interested in learning more about the Catholic Church; unbaptized and recognizing the need for spirituality in their lives; or baptized in the Catholic Church or another Christian faith tradition but never received any formal religious training. This includes any Catholic adults who were never confirmed and would like to receive that sacrament. **How long does it take?**

The Rite of Christian Initiation process ministers individually to those seeking membership. Some people need more time than others to prepare for a lifetime commitment. Do you use Gmail?

Or, move emails from the Promotions tab to the Primary tab. You can teach Gmail where to deliver future messages by moving a message from the Promotions tab to the Primary tab. Just select the message stored in the Promotions tab and drag it to the Primary tab. Gmail will then ask whether it should always deliver similar messages there.

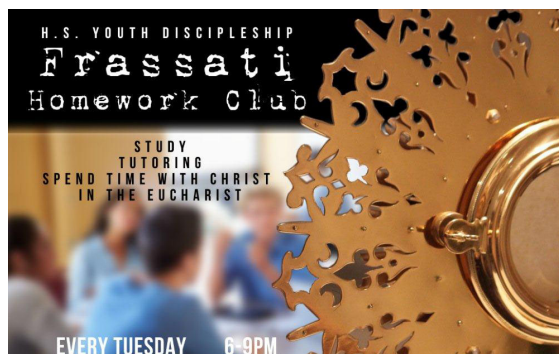

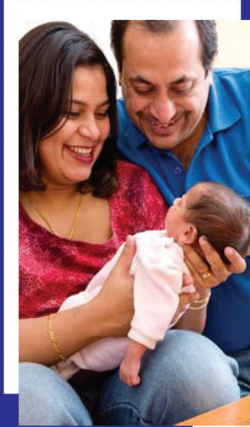
