## **Spiritual Poverty**

On this "Rejoice!" Sunday in Advent, we can pray in a particular way for an end to material poverty. Today's readings assure us that the kind of poverty God desires for us is spiritual poverty, a radical knowledge that all things come from God. Where material poverty can wound the human spirit, spiritual poverty cultivates boundless joy. John the Baptist provides a startling model for us. In all sincerity, he admits that he is not worthy to touch Jesus' sandals. John says this not to charm the crowds by being coy and self-deprecating. No, John embraces the truth that God is the source of all goodness. We are utterly dependent on God for all good things. We cannot do anything to earn God's favor; God simply provides for us because we need God. This is massively good news! No one could possibly care for us like God does. At our very best, we merely reflect God's brightness into the world. God's brilliant joy is exactly what we are called to. As Saint Paul says, "The one who calls you is faithful, and he will also accomplish it."

## **LeAnn's List of reminders about ... Advent**

"My teaching is not mine but His who sent me." John 7:16

✂Advent began on December 3 this year; it lasts the 4 weeks before Christmas, and is a season of preparation.

✂The liturgical color for Advent is **purple**.

✂Advent quite literally means "the start of something new". In our Catholic tradition we start the new Church year with a season of preparation for the Christmas season. The Greek and Latin roots of the word mean "to come"; hence, Christ comes to us both then and now and again at the Parousia (2<sup>nd</sup> coming of the Lord). That will surely be the start of something new!!!

✂The Advent wreath is circular as a sign that God has no beginning and no end. It is made of evergreen boughs as a sign that God is ever-present and alive.

✂The Advent wreath includes at least 4 candles as a sign that Jesus is the Light of the world. Each candle can be said to represent a thousand years of waiting for the Incarnation (birth of God as man in Jesus). The people of the Old Testament waited over 4,000 years for the birth of our Messiah at His first coming; now we await His second coming and no one knows how long our wait will be. One purple candle is lit the first week of Advent (hope). The second purple candle (and the first) is lit the second week of Advent (faith). The pink candle (and first two purple candles) is lit on Joyful Sunday (Gaudete Sunday) in the third week of Advent (joy). The fourth candle (purple) is lit in the fourth week of Advent with the others (peace). Each is a sign of our growing hope in Christ's coming. If a 5<sup>th</sup> candle is included, it is white and is lit on Christmas Day in the center (love). Another option is to replace the purple and pink candles with white candles when Advent ends on Christmas Day.

✂Advent is a time to prepare the heart to receive Jesus anew at Christmas time. He is reborn in us! His Light comes to the world through us when we love one another. During this season of preparation consider how you will renew your commitment to love Christ well. Here are some ideas:

- Make a good confession and celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation
- Attend daily Mass
- Read the holy Scriptures
- Advent is sometimes called "the little Lent" so consider doing penitential acts.
- Be a gift-giver!
- Wear purple and be conscious of prayer, penance and preparation throughout the season.
- Be charitable! Be joyful! Be hopeful! Be peaceful! Be loving!
- Prepare your heart more than your hearth (home and mantel)

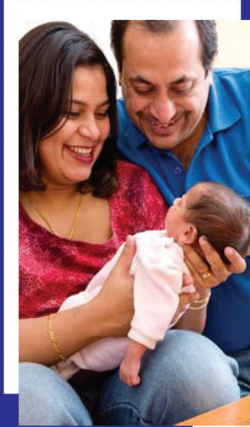

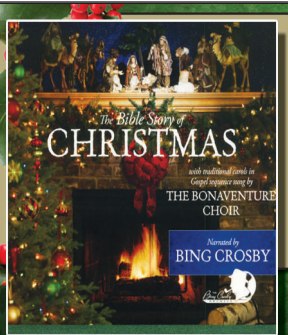


