### We Present Our Offering

- b. "Last Call" donations from the Winter Social covered the purchase of the new tractor for grounds maintenance.
- SCRIP sales trending downward. Proceeds from sales projected at ~
  \$37,500 for this fiscal year. People Pay process being considered.
