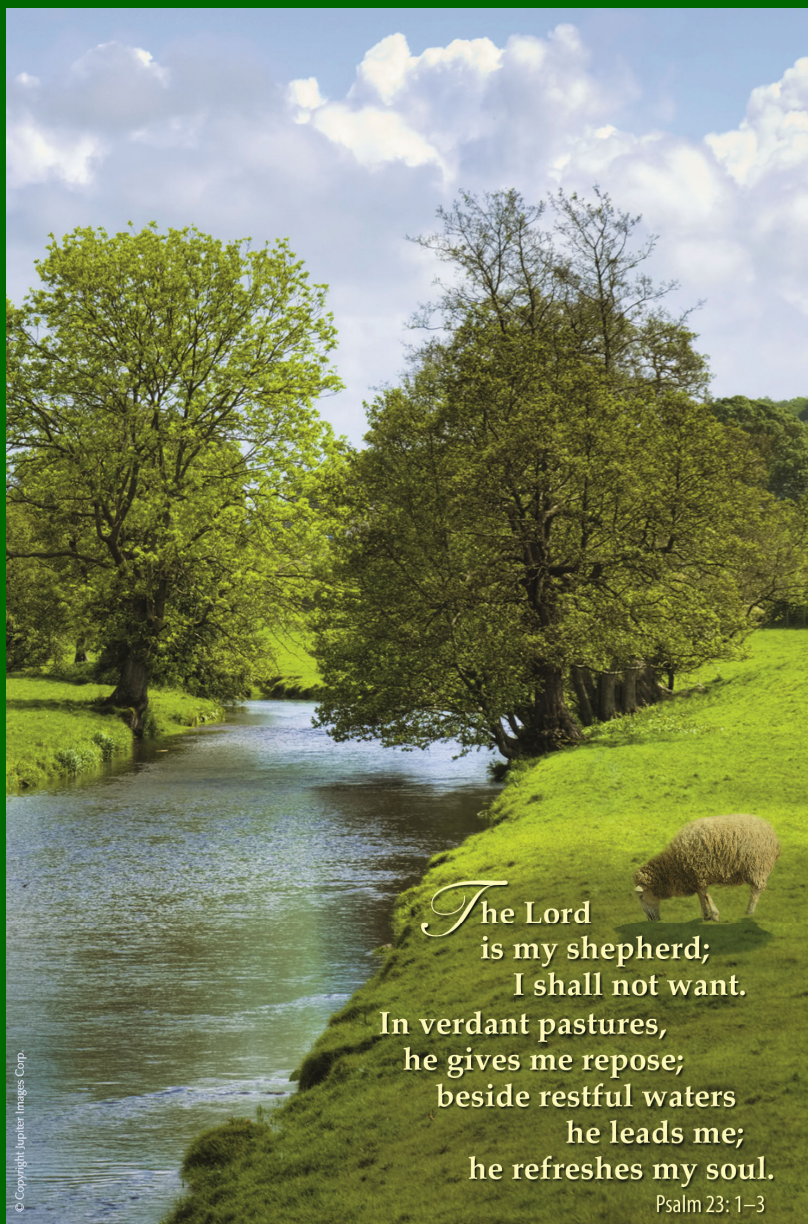

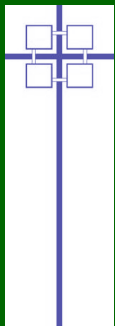
REST IN THE LORD

For several weeks we have listened to readings that have recounted just how arduous the work of prophets and disciples can be. In today's Gospel, the Lord Jesus listens to the reports of those he had sent out "two by two" to minister to the people. After the apostles reported what they had done, Jesus, recognizing their fatigue, says, "Come away by yourselves to a deserted place and rest awhile" (Mark 6:31). Perhaps this is what the Lord is telling his disciples in the year 2018 as well. We need to pause on our journey of discipleship and simply rest in the Lord. Get Ready for Some Solid Adult Faith Formation: Registration Closes August 31, 2018!

St. Anne has been chosen for a special University of Dallas Program.

Are you looking for good, solid formation? Do you wish you knew the Church's teachings on Key topics? As summer begins to wind down, now's a great time to be thinking of your own faith formation. The University of Dallas (UD) is offering St. Anne an exciting new Adult Faith Formation program, which was developed in cooperation with some of the leading professors at the UD. St. Anne has been chosen as a pilot parish for this program and we are inviting all adults in the parish to participate. The program begins with "Course I, The Person: Life and Community." This is an Introduction to Philosophical and Theological Anthropology and Catholic Social Teaching.

Among the most distinctive and essential of the Church's doctrines are those concerning the dignity and vocation of the human person. Made for life with God and with one another, for communion and friendship, we bring the Gospel to bear on every aspect of human life: marriage, family, society, government, and the economy. By the doing so, we humanize the whole culture, allowing our lives and our work to reflect the transcendent realities such as love, goodness, and beauty.

Sessions begin ***Wednesday, September 12, 2018*** at 6:45 p.m. at the parish and will run through ***November 14, 2018***. University of Dallas is one of the pre-eminent Catholic universities in the country. Due to the caliber of the program, the cost is \$150 per person. This is a fraction of the cost of college credits—and the content is on par with the caliber of college content. Individuals and businesses are invited to make donations, which will be used for scholarships for individuals who wish to attend but cannot afford it. Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Update:

A beloved program with our St. Anne Community, Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) has been a long standing program for our preschool children. This year, we will continue the essence of this program to allow for our preschoolers to encounter Christ. However, because this program requires extensive training and certification on the part of the catechist and is a trademark name, we must follow their requirements for implementation.

With LeAnn's departure, we no longer have someone within St. Anne who is certified to lead CGS, so we will be offering a similar program but it will simply be called Preschool Faith Formation. I'm committed to ensuring your children receive the same care and formation, allowing them to develop and experience friendship with Christ through enriching, engaging, and age appropriate activities. Our regularly scheduled preschool formation class will take place on ***Thursdays from 3-4:30 p.m.*** Please look for periodic updates regarding these changes. Thank you.

Kindergarten through 8th grade Updates

St. Anne's kindergarten through 8th grade program will remain largely the same throughout the upcoming year.

Elementary grade levels will continue to utilize the Our Sunday Visitor *Alive in Christ* curriculum. Classes are held on the first three Saturdays of the month from 4-5 p.m., Sundays at 8 a.m.—10:30 a.m., and Wednesdays from 5:30-6:30 p.m. Parents of First Communicants (2nd graders), please mark your calendars for the following dates:

- **First Reconciliation Parent Orientation** on Sunday, November 4, 2018 at both 8 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. Faith Formation classes.
- **First Reconciliation Retreat for First Communicants and Parents** on Saturday, November 17, 2018 1-4 p.m.
- **First Reconciliation Celebration of the Sacrament** on Wednesday, December 5, 2018 at 6 p.m.

The middle school program remains in the wonderful, expert hands of Erin Tidd. Our middle school grade levels will continue to use *The Catholic Connections Handbook for Middle Schoolers* by Saint Mary's Press. All 7th and 8th graders should bring their copy to the first class. New students will be provided a copy. Classes are held on the first three Saturdays of the month from 4-5 p.m. and the second and fourth Sundays of the month from 6-8 p.m. Parents of middle schoolers, please be aware that in lieu of Sunday Faith Formation classes in November there will be an off-campus service project on November 11th. The location TBD.

High School Faith Formation and Confirmation Prep

High School Faith Formation, which is for 9th through 11th grade, prepares students to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation in their junior year of high school. The program will essentially remain the same this year with just a few changes. Here's an overview of the key highlights:

- **Curriculum:** All grades 9th, 10th, and 11th grades—will use Matthew Kelly's Decision Point Curriculum. We will spread out the curriculum over three years to ensure each grade focuses on specific video modules, allowing for rich small group conversations.
- **Catechist:** Most of our high school catechists are returning! They will serve your children in small groups and journey with them throughout the year.
- **Confirmation Prep:** This program is intended to prepare students for the Sacrament of Confirmation their junior year in high school. Attendance is essential to prepare adequately and gain the most from the program.
- **Class Times:** Classes will meet on the 1st Sunday of the month from 6-7:30 p.m., and 3rd Sundays of the month from 6-8 p.m. We will have discussion by class grade and also large group community and worship.
- **Serving at Mass:** Students will continue to serve at the 11:30 Mass on the 3rd Sunday of the month. All students will have the opportunity to serve in a variety of ways: lecturing, ushering, acolyting, and greeting! It's a way for Mass to come alive for our students.
- **Retreat:** There will be a St. Anne—only retreat on November 9/10. This will give our students the chance to bond with each other and encounter our Lord as a St. Anne high school community.
- **LifeNite:** Led by Rich Sosa, Director of the Music and Youth Ministry will continue on the 4th Sunday of the month from 6-8 p.m.! This is a time to relax and have fun among peers.
