THE INSIDE SHOWS

In this third Sunday of our reading from the Sermon on the Plain, Jesus speaks of the inner soul and its outer expression. He uses images as he teaches. He addresses all of us. Jesus sees a plumb line connecting the soul with the soul's expression—words and actions. He uses exaggeration to drive home his point. We are urged to clear out the debris that blinds us. He knows that we have an uncanny ability to be blind to our own weaknesses, though they be as big as a board. He knows, too, how willingly we seem to ferret out others' smallest speck-like flaws. And this, too, is for our general consumption; solid old goodness and solid old badness will show eventually. The old Latin saying, which echoes Jesus' images, is true: "What is bred in the bone will out in the flesh." By and by, the inside will show through.

What is Your 2019 Lenten Program?

Wednesday, **March 6, 2019** is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of 40 Days of Lent. Now's a good time to begin thinking of your Lenten Program. The Church teaches that we should focus on: Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving. "These express conversion in relation to oneself, to God, and to others...and foster radical purification." (CCC 1434). Our Church also teaches one should receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation at least once per year. Lent is often the most opportune time of the year to take on this practice. It's not only freeing because it reconciles you with our Lord, it allows your heart to become open to God's promptings in your life. If you haven't been to confession in awhile, do not be afraid. Fr. Bob will guide you through that process. Here are some ideas on your own or within the parish.

Prayer:

- ✚ Attend Mass at least one additional time during the week (Tuesdays at 5:15 p.m., Wednesday through Friday at noon, Saturday's at 8:30 a.m.)
- ✚ Attend Holy Hour where the Blessed Sacrament is Exposed: Tuesdays at 6:00 p.m. or Wednesdays at 12:30 p.m. following Mass
- ✚ Pray the Rosary each day
- ✚ Participate in a study with your spouse on FORMED.org (access code: YYPV23)
- ✚ Start a new book on prayer, "Conversion with Christ" by Peter T. Rohrbach
- ✚ Start praying with your spouse
- ✚ Pray before meals at restaurants

Fasting:

Adults are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This applies to adults 18 to 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Abstaining from meat on all Fridays during Lent is required for all individuals age 14 and above

What are you going to give up during Lent?

- ✚ What virtue do you want to work on?

- ✚ Clean out your closets and donate to St. Vincent de Paul
- ✚ Buy lunch for a friend in need
- ✚ Donate a meal to a parishioner in need

- ✚ Give an extra donation to the parish

These are all just ideas. Discuss as a family and determine your plan. Lent is a wonderful time to re-order our lives -- turn back to Christ and allow more room for him to work in our lives.

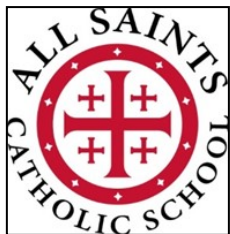
