*Greetings to the people of St. Anne's!* My name is Daniel Smyth, and I am a seminarian at St. Francis De Sales Seminary. As part of my formation, I have been assigned to assist Fr. Bob with his ministry.

My parents raised my four brothers and me in a small country town in central Wisconsin. We lived the faith of the Catholic Church, played hockey, and enjoyed the outdoors. After high school, I attended the University of Norte Dame, and I graduated in 2014 with a degree in mechanical engineering.


