With any luck, summer delights will continue a while past last weekend's Labor Day: refreshing recreation (with maybe an occasional swim) or enjoyable relaxation on the deck (with tasty outdoor grilling). Truth is, for some of us, this year's Labor Day came way too early. For instance, Wisdom reminds us that believers in God can never be content with "timid deliberations" and "unsure plans." Jesus instructs "great crowds" traveling with him—including us—on three things necessary for all true disciples to accomplish.
