## **CHANGE**

Lent is all about change and change is usually not easy. In order to change we have to leave something behind. Today we hear about a very old man who decides to answer God's call. Abram experiences a tremendous amount of change when he leaves everything behind, risking it all for God's promise. Jesus changes, is transfigured, right before the eyes of his disciples. The Lenten scriptures issue the call for us to change, to be transfigured, so that we, too, will soon share in the glory of God. What is it that the Lord is asking us to leave behind? Are we willing to take the risk for the promise made by God? These questions are at the heart of the Lenten journey of conversion.

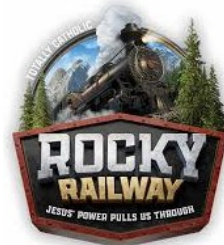

### **GRACE Group Begins New Study for Lent Metanoia, a New 10-part Documentary Series by Fr. Dave Pivonka**

All women in the parish are invited to attend GRACE Group this Lenten season where a new video



series, *Metanoia*, will be shown, which features Fr. Dave Pivonka, TOR, well-known author, international speaker and president of Franciscan University. *Metanoia* is a Greek word that means conversion: to change, to repent, to turn, and to think differently. Apropos for the Lenten season, viewers will be taken through the Holy Land into a more profound understanding of Jesus' deep and abiding love and his call to conversion. Through captivating stories and beautiful cinematography, the series, filmed on location in the Holy Land, leads viewers on an inspirational journey of grace, hope, repentance, and transformation.

Throughout the series, the episodes will unpack the meaning of metanoia. "As Christians, we are entreated to live an ongoing life of metanoia," Fr. Dave explained. "This series invites us to a deeper and more profound conversion—a metanoia—that moves us from something to someone, as metanoia ultimately turns us to Jesus."

The half-hour episodes showcase the grand landscape and architecture of the Holy Land alongside stories of encounter and conversion from a Jewish convert, a biblical scholar, an Eastern-Rite sister, and many others.

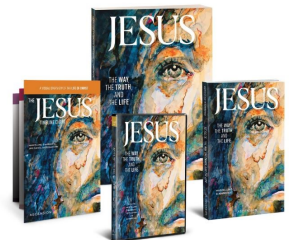
