ST. ANNE CORONAVIRUS UPDATE

Per the directives of the Archdiocese of Milwaukee, the following precautions will be taken:

- Seating will be restricted to every other pew.
- There will be teams of volunteers after each Mass that will clean/disinfect the church. If you would like to volunteer for one of the cleaning teams please contact Matthew at the Parish Office and let him know which Mass you will be attending!
- There will be an overflow area in the gathering once the church has reached 25% capacity. There will be chairs already set up. Feel free to move the chairs as needed to accommodate your family. These chairs will also be disinfected after each Mass.

Offertory Procedures

- For the offertory, we will not pass the baskets through the church, but rather place baskets in the sanctuary. You can leave your offering before or after Mass, or during the offertory time.

Communion Procedures

- Communion will ONLY be distributed by Fr. Bob. During the distribution of the Eucharist, Fr. Bob will come to each person as they are kneeling in the pew. Please do not leave the pews during Communion.

**The dispensation from the Sunday Obligation to attend Mass has been extended to July 5th.*

DEVOTIONAL & PRAYER LIFE

REFLECTION FROM DEACON RICH:

TRINITY: THE SIGN OF THE CROSS

On this the feast of the Most Holy Trinity we have one of the shortest gospel readings of the year. There are only three lines to the Gospel, and it takes just two minutes to read. The first line we are all very familiar with, "God so loved the world that He gave His only Son." This was such a very precious gift to us by God. Then stop to think, we received the gift of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost. God loves us so much that He gives us everything He has of the greatest value and gives it to us with joy and love that we need to pray to understand more and more.

Therefore we have God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. They are all in one, a mystery that we have, but one that we acknowledge every time we proclaim the sign of the cross. The sign of the cross expresses our faith in the Trinity. When we make the sign of the cross it must be made with respect and dignity. There is a good reason for that. The sign of the cross is a blessing that we bestow on ourselves acknowledging our faith and trust in the mystery of the greatest gifts God has bestowed on us.

The sign of the cross must be done carefully and with all the reverence we give to any other sacramental because that is what it is, a sacramental. Stop to think, first, we are using the sign of God's love for us, the cross that Jesus gave His life to save us with the movement of our hand. Second, we are using the name of God who is our Father the creator of the universe. Third, we mention His Son Jesus who died on that cross just for us that we are making with our hand. Third, we have the Holy Spirit who gives us the gifts we need to help us to be better people in this world.

So each time we make the sign of the cross we are forming the Trinity with our own hand recognizing God as our Father and the two greatest gifts He has given us and the cross on which His Son has offered it all for us. We acknowledge our belief in the Trinity that exists, this mystery that no one can explain but we know is there in this beautiful sacramental that we form each time we make the sign of the cross.

The next time we make the sign of the cross we can remember that we are forming a very special sign, (not a fast father, son, holy spirit, with a quick circle), but a true sign of God's love for us.

"In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." Amen.
