DEVOTIONAL & PRAYER LIFE

REFLECTION FROM DEACON RICH:

DO NOT BE AFRAID

WOW! What a powerful message Jesus is delivering to us today. Maybe it is fitting that Jesus says to His disciples three times some variation of “fear not” or “do not be afraid.” The disciples and this also includes us are to be fearless. Well who is the basis for this fearlessness, the Father, who knows all, even the most insignificant things that we don’t know like the amount of hairs on our head. Just think about it, the Father even knows each and every sparrow. What Jesus is saying is just how much more valuable we are in the whole scheme of things than the rest of the world.

Today we are faced with a lot of fear all around us. We have had the corona pandemic virus for months and it has been trying to destroy us with fear. But most of all it has been trying to destroy our faith. It has created a fear of people, a fear of allowing church, a fear of allowing Mass, and a fear of the reception of the Eucharist. But Jesus tells us, “do not be afraid.” We must continue with the Mass now that it started and be the disciples to evangelize our faith community to come to the Mass now on Sundays and “fear not.” Follow Jesus’ words and this Gospel He is giving us.

Encourage all fellow parishioners of the strength of the Mass and the Eucharist. Jesus died on the cross for us and He has given this specifically to us to remember Him, to love Him, to worship Him. It is through the Mass and the Eucharist we will get the graces to fight the virus and come out healthy and strong.

Today we now also have the other fear, the fear of killings, shootings, wild protestors with anger generating more fear into the world. We have the police now the ones being feared by the public instead of being respected for the protection they really give us. Yesterday a police officer was shot in Chicago chasing an armed felon who committed a crime. He was shot by the thief. The thief was caught by two other police officers before others would get hurt. “Fear not” because it is the Father who is watching over us all, and protecting us through our police officers.

Every day the news is giving us something very negative in the world. But it is only through our participation and prayer in the Mass that all the aforementioned can be alleviated. So where is our good news today? It is in the Lord. The good news is that all will be made right, despite the pain and suffering that we see each day. As bad as it is, God’s grace is even greater. Through that one man, Jesus Christ, God’s grace overflows. We may suffer and be ignored, and we may witness destruction all around us. But our hope is in the Lord, and He will save us. The answer, Mass and the Eucharist.
