	Mass with your family. Participating in the Mass and receiving the Sacraments is the
	best way to guide your children in the Faith. Christ gives us a share in His Divine Life
	through the Eucharist and Reconciliation, and when you receive these Sacraments, you bring His Life into your home!
	Our primary goal as parents and teachers is to help each child know that he or she is loved
_	by Jesus and by us, and to help them become the saints He is calling them to be! Together, let
	us pray for a year in which all of the children in our care may come to know the truth and
	goodness of His love in a deeper way.
	Please arrive on time each week at the beginning and end of each class. Arriving too early
	may interrupt the catechist's important preparations. Arriving late interrupts the
	learning that has already begun in your absence. Catechists and others may be trying to
	come to or from Mass in a prompt fashion. Our 59 minutes together are precious!
	Please note that home formation is an expectation. While catechists may reference the
	theme from the workbook each week, they will likely develop activities that support
	chapter content in more profound ways. Our job is to reinforce what you're teaching at
	home. Decide how you will practice and teach the Faith at home and create a rhythm
	that works for YOUR family. If you would like access to additional resources and
	materials, please don't hesitate to contact your child's teacher or Mary Mowry.
	Please pray as a family throughout the week. Set aside time to come together as a family
	outside of Mass each week to pray and reflect on where God is leading you and how He
	is revealing Himself to you. Unity in prayer is one of the greatest gifts you can give your
	family!
	Please pray for our catechists. Our catechists are volunteers. While some are certified
	teachers, most are not. All love teaching your children in the best ways they know how.
	Please be generous with your compliments, and charitable in your constructive criticism.
	Consider volunteering your help! If you have a question or concern regarding a catechist,
	please don't hesitate to contact DRE Mary Mowry.

Please plan to do something special with the hour. You are always welcome to pray near the Blessed Sacrament in the Sanctuary during your child's class. Fr. Bob will often offer the Sacrament of Reconciliation during our FF classes so you may participate in Christ's love and mercy. Read or mingle with other parents away from our class spaces. Our Gathering Area is for you to get to know one another better and make more friends in Christ. Registration Form

The Preschool - 5th Grade Faith Formation Form may be completed by visiting the "Children" Registration page on the St. Anne website. Please go to <u>saint-anne.org</u> to register by July 31, 2022.

Fee

The \$100.00 fee covers preparation workbooks, retreat materials, and children's missals. The fee is due September 30, 2022.

Baptismal Certificate

A copy of your child's Baptismal certificate (not a birth certificate) must be submitted prior to the reception of the sacraments. Baptismal certificates may be emailed as files or photos to Mary Mowry at mmowry@saint-anne.org. Alternatively, a hardcopy may be dropped off at the parish office during our normal office hours. If your child was baptized at St. Anne's, there is no need to submit a copy as we have a record of the baptism. Please submit your child's Baptismal certificate by November 1, 2022.

Preparation Policy Parent Agreement

This form serves to notify our pastor Fr. Bob Weighner of your intent to prepare your child to receive the sacraments of Reconciliation and First Holy Communion. By reading and signing this agreement, you indicate your commitment to the policy. The Parent Agreement is due September 30, 2022.

Pastor Connection

It's good practice to get to know your pastor. Be sure to introduce yourselves to Fr. Bob Weighner after Mass on occasion, and let him know you have a child preparing for First Communion. Also, knowing that the pastor is always available to you, don't hesitate to set up an appointment with him if you'd like to talk about the faith in your home or any questions you might have.

PARENT MEETINGS

There are two required half-day parent-only sessions which are offered at varying times throughout the year. Please select the session date that is the most convenient for you and your family. At least one parent must be in attendance at each meeting. Children should not attend.

FAITH FORMATION CLASSES

Participation in our Faith Formation classes is an essential component of our sacramental preparation program. Children are required to attend their three scheduled classes each month. *More than three unexcused absences may delay reception of the sacraments until the following year.* All Saints Catholic School and St. Joseph Catholic Academy students will complete formation through the schools.

RETREATS

We offer three sacramental preparation retreats throughout the year. These retreats are required for all First Communicants and their parents. *At least one parent must be in attendance.* Please select either the Saturday or Sunday retreat.

- First Reconciliation Retreat | Sat., October 29 **OR** Sun., October 30, 2022 1 4 pm
- First Communion Retreat # 1 | Sat., March 18 OR Sun., March 19, 2023 1 4 pm

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION WORKBOOKS

Each family will receive a copy of My Booklet about God's Love and Forgiveness (Reconciliation) and My Booklet about the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist (Communion). These booklets are intended for you to continue preparation at home. The booklets feature stories, discussions, and activity pages. Please read the stories and complete the activities with your child. Children must complete the writing/drawing. Completed workbooks are due at the following times:

- First Reconciliation workbook submit at the First Reconciliation Retreat
- First Communion workbook submit at First Communion Retreat # 1

PRAYERS

It is our expectation that families regularly pray together. At the time of their First Holy Communion, children should be able to prayerfully recite the following prayers: Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be, Grace Before Meals, the Act of Contrition. Please take the time to help your children learn these prayers. Children should also know how to properly make the Sign of the Cross and how to reverently genuflect when entering the church.

CELEBRATION OF THE SACRAMENTS

First Reconciliation

As parents, your own humble and positive disposition toward receiving God's mercy and forgiveness will give great witness to your children. They will approach the sacrament with joy, peace, and confidence if you set an example by receiving the sacrament regularly yourself.

Please prepare your child for this sacrament by reviewing the Ten Commandments, walking him/her through an examination of conscience, and teaching them the Act of Contrition. These materials can all be found on our St. Anne website under the "First Reconciliation & First Eucharist" page.

First Communicants will celebrate First Reconciliation on November 9, 2022 at 6 pm.

Children may receive the sacrament by sitting face-to-face with the priest or kneeling behind a screen. Please help your child determine which option he/she may prefer.

First Holy Communion

First Communion will take place on Sunday, May 7, 2023 at our 9:15 am and 11:30 am Masses and on Saturday, May 13, 2023 at our 5:15 pm Mass.

First Communion rehearsals are scheduled as follows:

- May 4, 2023
 - o 5:15 pm rehearsal for our 9:15 am Mass on May 7th
 - o 6:15 pm rehearsal for our 11:30 am Mass on May 7th
- May 11, 2023
 - o 5:15 pm rehearsal for our 5:15 pm Mass on May 13th

A child must know the difference between ordinary bread and the Extraordinary Eucharist. They must recognize that Holy Communion is not like regular food and be able to distinguish the difference. In addition, a child must believe that the Host is really and truly Jesus, and that He is fully present to us in the Eucharist.

Children will receive their First Holy Communion while kneeling at a kneeler. They may receive on the tongue or in the hand. The Communion fast begins one hour before the reception of Communion. Children should refrain from consuming any food or drink (except water or medication) unless it is medically necessary that they not fast.

First Communion attire should reflect your child's dignity as a son or daughter of God. Generally, boys wear suits (any conservative color -- white, black, navy, light gray, etc.); however, some wear long or short-sleeved button-downs with a tie and khakis. Girls often wear white dresses and veils; however, there is no need for the dress to be new.



PREPARATION POLICY PARENT AGREEMENT

Having reviewed the requirements for sacramental preparation, I will strive to fully engage and participate in my child's preparation for First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion, especially by:

- Attending Mass each Sunday and on Holy Days of Obligation. If we are unable to attend
 Mass at St. Anne's, we will attend Mass at another parish (see Kenosha Area Mass Times
 sheet).
- Helping my child with faith formation assignments.
- Praying with my child at home.
- Sending my child to his/her faith formation classes and ensuring they arrive on time and are present for the entire class time.
- Attending the required parent sessions.
- Encouraging my child's engagement and participation at each sacramental preparation retreat.
- Ensuring my child receives First Reconciliation prior to First Holy Communion.

I understand that failure to complete these requirements may delay my child's reception of these sacraments this year; however, the sacraments will be administered later when my child and I can complete these requirements.

Youth in high school formation will receive their Safeguarding lesson in April 2023. If you'd like to join them, you are welcome and encouraged to attend with your child during his/her regularly scheduled Faith Formation class that week. If you prefer your child opt out of this lesson, please complete, sign, and return the reverse side of this letter to your child's catechist during his/her final class in October.
